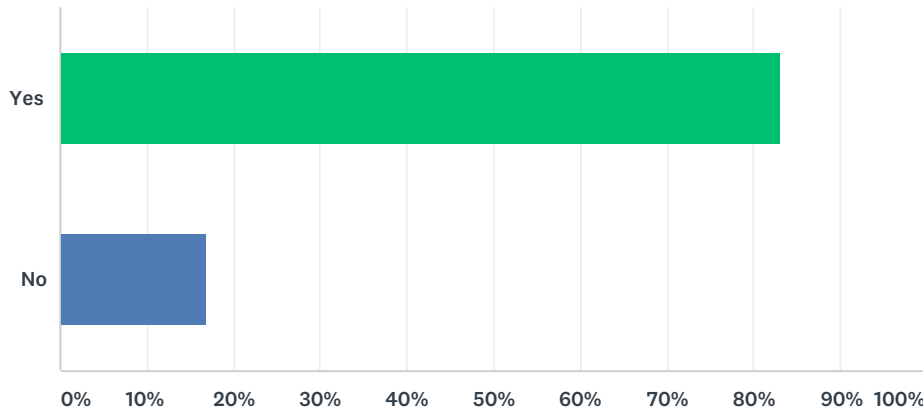


Q1 Have you taken an ethics course as part of your paralegal program?

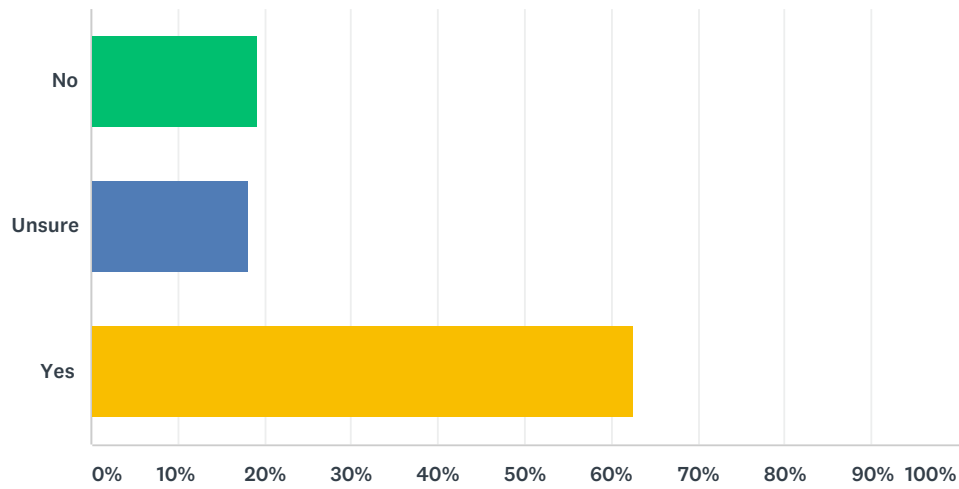

Q2 Did your program's ethics training include reviewing case studies related to paralegals and UPL?

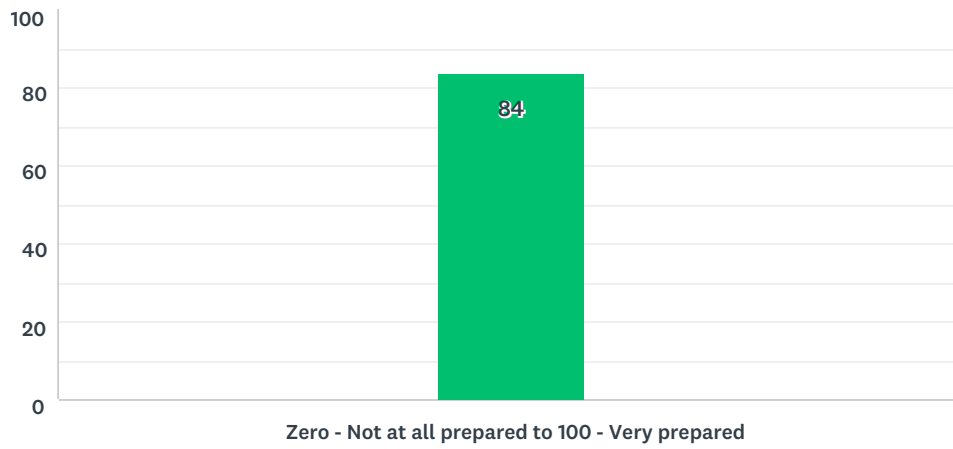

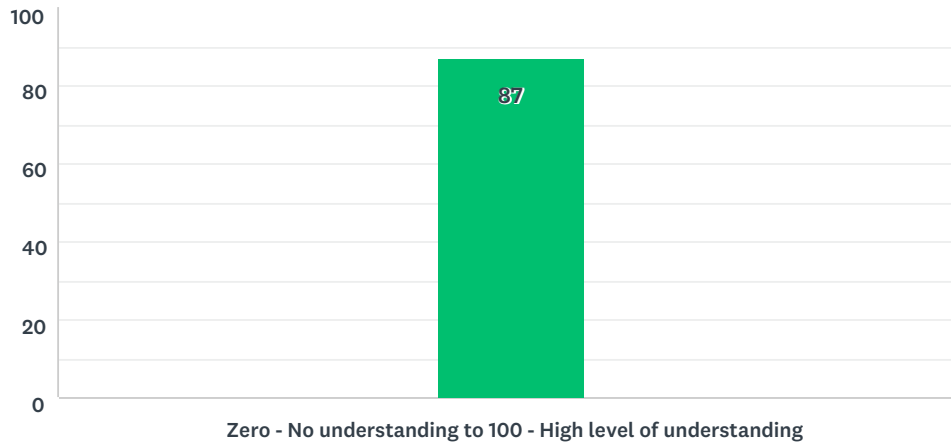
Q3 How prepared do you feel, as a result of your paralegal program, to identify and address ethical concerns in your paralegal career?

Q4 How well do you feel you understand ethical rules regarding the unauthorized practice of law (UPL)?

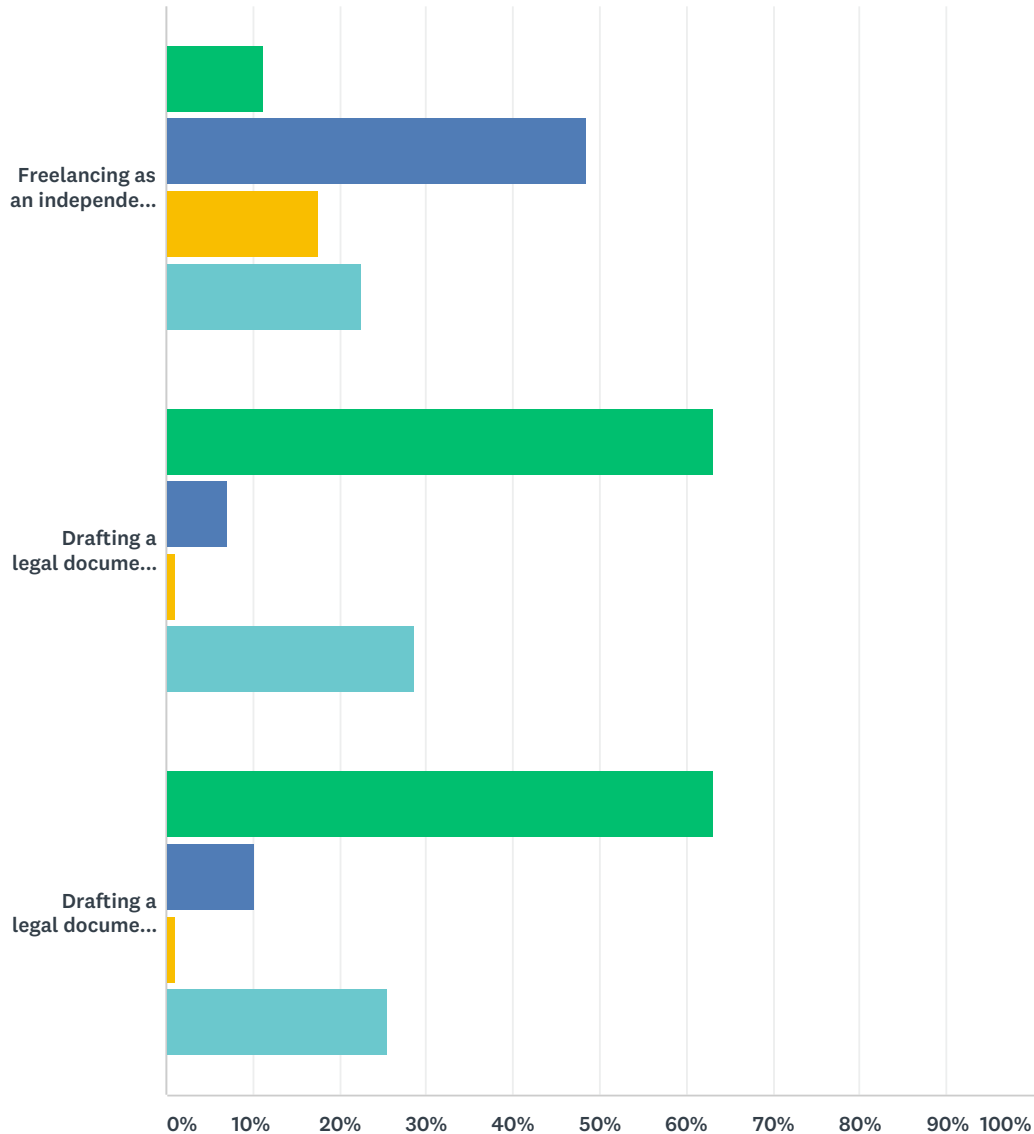
